Submissions must be:

Original - No more than 2 years old - Must include the dimensions of the work and must be under 48" x 48".
Digital images: 1200 pixels at the largest dimension and display at 300 dpi.

Submission Requirements:

The Spring Art Exhibition is open to all artists submitting recent work in two and three dimensions. All submissions must be original and created by the submitting artist.

1. The Spring Art Exhibition selections will be determined by the AGC Selection Committee.
2. The "People's Choice Award" will be determined by the attendees of the exhibit.
3. The submission fee is \$20 per piece or \$45 for 3. More than 3 pieces may be submitted.
4. The submission fee is non-refundable and is due upon submission of artwork images or pieces.
5. Artists are notified of Spring Art Exhibition selection results by a list on the AGC web site by 4/3/19.
6. **All accepted artwork must be dropped off for hanging between 4:30 and 8 pm on Monday, April 1st and picked up at the close of the show on Sunday, April 7th, between 5-8pm.**
7. **All WORK MUST BE GALLERY READY, SAWTOOTH HANGERS, OR CLIP FRAMES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ALL 2-D/WALL MOUNTED WORK MUST BE WIRED FOR HANGING.**
8. Artwork must be labeled: artist name, title of work, medium, and price if for sale.
9. Accepted work will be hung in the gallery at the discretion of the show co-chairs. The gallery reserves the right not to hang work that does not resemble submitted images.
10. All sales will be through the AGC with a 20% commission paid. All sales will be recorded and proceeds will be paid to the artists within 2 weeks of show's completion.
11. Please consider volunteering to help staff the show and represent your work.
