ART in the PARK is an annual juried art event sponsored by the Artists' Group of Charlestown.

Since 1998, **ART in the PARK** has consistently attracted talented artists from the New England area, becoming an extremely popular fine art event.

ART in the PARK 2020 will be held in the award winning City Square Park, Charlestown, MA on Saturday, August 29th, 2020 (rain date Sunday, August 30th).

Event and Participant Information:

The Committee will review and accept applicants based on creativity, originality of the work and presentation. Only original works will be considered. Various mediums including acrylic, oil, mixed media and watercolor painting, original prints and/or limited editions prints, photography, sculpture, glass and pottery, jewelry, fabric, textile and other fine art are acceptable.

- Space within the Park is limited to 65 artists.
- Exhibition space is 10 feet by 10 feet per artist.
- All set up, tear down, display materials and clean-up are the exhibitor's responsibility.
- Tents and/or Canopies can be used, if all sidewalls remain open and you provide your own weights to secure your panels/tents in case of windy conditions. STAKES ARE NOT PERMITTED, due to the underground sprinkler system.
- Artists are required to represent their original work only.
- The event runs from 10 am-5:30 pm with set up beginning at 8am. Artists are expected to be present for the entire event.
